**Subject: Commencement of New Academic Session 2026-27 -reg.**

Dear Madam/Sir,

With reference to the above-mentioned subject, it is requested to ensure that in all EMRSs the Academic Session 2026-27 shall commence immediately after the declaration of results of the session 2025-26. Under no circumstances, shall students be granted permission to avail holidays after the completion of examinations. There shall be no break between the conclusion of examinations and the commencement of the new academic session.

Schools shall utilize the initial period of the session for organizing bagless days incorporating experiential learning, art-integrated learning, sports, skill education, and other co-curricular activities to ensure a smooth and joyful transition of students into the new academic session. With regard to students of class X, who will be promoted to class XI (2026-27), by considering the Quantum jump in curriculum, bridge courses may be focused.

In this regard, it is requested to issue necessary instructions to all EMRSs under your jurisdiction to make advance plannings for the seamless commencement of the session without any delay. Schools shall ensure proper academic planning, including preparation of timetables, teaching schedules, and appropriate resource allocation.

Further, it shall be ensured that:

1. Distribution of stationery, including notebooks and textbooks to all students is to be completed positively by **31<sup>st</sup> March 2026**.
2. As per the split-up syllabus, which will be circulated shortly the syllabus allocated for the months of April and May 2026 shall be completed before summer vacation.
3. In respect of class VI students, house allotment may be done on the same day of confirmation of admission with TC.
4. Bridge Course for Class VI shall be commenced at the beginning of the session 2026-27 in April 2026.
5. Preparation of fortnightly lesson plan diaries by teachers and its submission to Principal on 01<sup>st</sup> & 16<sup>th</sup> of every month excluding vacation period.
6. Various student leadership appointments shall be completed in a timely and systematic manner at the beginning of the academic session.

7. First round at Academic Classroom observation of every teacher as per **Annexure-1** by the Principal/Principal in-charge to be completed positively by **30th April 2026**.

8. Allotment of stream at the Senior secondary level has to be decided as per the performance, criteria of CBSE and the willingness of parent/students. In case, if the parent wants his ward to study under a particular stream, which may be difficult for the student to cope up, necessary counselling may be done by the Principal & teachers.

9. All efforts are to be made to ensure that the students who have appeared for class X (AISSE-2026) examination continue their studies in EMRS itself.
